Free children's rights training for under 18s in England

We are offering 20 groups across England a FREE children's rights training session.

We are looking for host organisations (schools, youth groups, youth clubs and any other setting providing space or services to children and young people) to help us reach under 18s all over England.

We are particularly looking for groups of children and young people who face barriers in exercising their rights (e.g. children with disabilities; those in conflict with the law; refugee and asylum seeking children and young people; children and young people living in poor areas; under 10s). The training can be provided at weekends or evenings, and can be from 2.5 hours long, to a full day.

Training will cover: **children's rights, human rights, taking action and getting legal advice**. We will also be inviting local legal advice services to co-deliver the training days.

What we will do:

- Provide 20 groups with FREE training sessions
- Deliver the training to groups of between 10 and 30 under 18 year-olds
- Tailor the training for your group
- Provide all the resources
- Arrange for a local legal expert to come to the session/provide information about their services for children and young people.
